**HERSHEY FCU BOARD OF DIRECTORS RE-ELECTED**

**HUMMELSTOWN, PA** -- Hershey Federal Credit Union held its annual membership meeting on April 25. During the meeting, Louise Lingenfelser, Barbara McLaughlin and Richard Miller were re-elected to the board of directors.

Lingenfelser was appointed to the board in January 2018 after Francois Houde resigned. She works full time for the Pennsylvania Army National Guard and resides in Palmyra. She is the first board member to be promoted from HFCU's associate board member program and has a long history in the credit union movement. Her mother was the chief executive officer of the former ClearChoice FCU in Reading.

McLaughlin joined the board in 2002 after serving on the supervisory committee for 10 years. She is retired from Hershey Entertainment and Resorts. A Palmyra resident, McLaughlin comes from a family with strong credit union experience, as her father helped organize a credit union in the Lehigh Valley in the 1960's.

Miller, a retiree of The Hershey Company, serves as chairman of the board and has been an HFCU volunteer for 33 years. He joined the credit committee in 1985 and the board of directors in 1994. He resides in Annville with his wife Diane.

During the board's re-organization meeting after the annual meeting, Frank Wagner was named treasurer. He has been an HFCU volunteer for 34 years. Prior to joining the board in 1991, he served on the credit committee. He is employed by The Hershey Company and resides in Lebanon with his wife Renee.
